



of Americans think the federal government should provide more funding and support for small- and mid-sized farms.

of Americans think there should be more government oversight of industrial-scale animal farms.


of Americans would support measures to prohibit new concentrated animal feeding operations (CAFOs) from being built.

of Americans support the continuation of conservation programs that help farmers maintain environmental quality of their land.



## Fund the Farm Bill




85% of Americans want to maintain or increase farm bill funding.




60% believe the government should be doing more to meet the needs of people.




feel that funding for SNAP, or the food stamp program, should be maintained.
